Future Software Developers Take Their First Step into the Industry at Istanbul Commerce University

The Ticar@ Software Developer Academy, launched by Istanbul Commerce University with support from the Istanbul Development Agency, has introduced 118 aspiring developers to the software industry. Graduates showcased their projects at the Career Summit, gaining recognition from the technology sector and taking their first steps into the professional world. The event also featured a panel discussion focusing on the impact of smart city technologies and digitalization on employment.

Istanbul Commerce University implemented the Ticar@ Software Developer Academy and Employment Center Project with the support of the Istanbul Development Agency. As part of the Ministry of Industry and Technology's National Technology Initiative, the project was carried out in collaboration with Istanbul Chamber of Commerce (ITO), Technopark Istanbul, Esenler Municipality, the Economic Research Foundation, and Beta Knowledge Association under the university's Technology Transfer Office.

A total of 118 participants, who successfully completed intensive training and boot camps, showcased their projects at the Career Summit held at the university's Sutluce Campus. At least 60% of



the graduates are expected to be employed under the project. The event drew participation from notable figures, including Ertan Ünal from Istanbul Chamber of Commerce's Project and Business

Development Department, Ibrahim Elbasi, General Manager of the Commercialization Center of Istanbul (BTM), Prof. Dr. Hanifi Parlar, Vice Rector of Istanbul Commerce University, Mustafa

Çalış, President of TÜYAFED, Özkan Can, Team Leader at Technopark Istanbul Incubation Center, academicians, and graduates. Research and development firms also set up recruitment stands during the event.

New Horizons in Technical Training

Dr. İlker Köse, Coordinator of Istanbul Commerce University's Technology Transfer Office, delivered the opening speech, highlighting the academy's success in filling gaps in technical education and supplying the industry with skilled software developers. Dr. Köse expressed hope that similar initiatives would become more widespread in the future.

Integration with Industry and Employment

Prof. Dr. Mehmet Hakan Hocaoglu, Dean of the Faculty of Engineering, emphasized the importance of integrating education with industry beyond university programs. He congratulated participants for successfully completing an intensive program exceeding 500 hours of training supported by İSTKA.

A Step Towards Making Istanbul a Technology Hub

Dr. Ziya Taşkent, Secretary-General of the Istanbul Development Agency, noted that these projects contribute to Istanbul's technology and entrepreneurship ecosystem. He stated that under the Talent Istanbul Program, the initiative not only educates young talents but also integrates them into the workforce. He described the project as a significant step toward transforming Istanbul into a global technology hub by equipping individuals with expertise in specialized subfields.



Intensive Training and High Achievements

Associate Professor Sabri Öz, the project's academic advisor, explained that the program spanned approximately six months, including 480 hours of training and a 26-day boot camp. He highlighted that the projects were designed to address industry needs and that participants exhibited exceptional performance.

Value Addition in R&D and Entrepreneurship

The program continued with a panel discussion titled "Value-Generating Company Projects and Desired Qualifications of R&D Teams." Moderated by Associate Professor Öz, the session featured speakers such as İbrahim Elbasi, who discussed BTM's role in supporting entrepreneurs, Rıdvan Yılmaz, General Manager of Techsoft Software, who underscored the demand for skilled personnel, and Emre Hekim, Chairman of IQ Vision, who stressed the need for software developers to continually improve themselves. Akif Emrah Büyüksomer, President of Beta Knowledge Association's Education Academy, emphasized the importance of interdisciplinary approaches in R&D for creating value.

Focus on Employment and Entrepreneurship in Smart City Technologies

Another panel, "Public Sector Projects in Smart City Technologies and Employment Impact," addressed the digital transformation initiatives of public institutions and their effects on employment. Moderated by Muti Rumelli, Chairman of MRC Group, the panel featured speakers such as Yunus Kurt, General Manager of Technopark Esenler, who discussed the employment benefits of smart city projects in Esenler. Bekir Selçuk Temel, Innovation and Technology Manager of Başakşehir Municipality, highlighted their Living Lab model and acceleration programs that support the commercialization of innovative projects. Cüneyt Yılmaz, IT Manager of Bağcılar Municipality, detailed the benefits of projects like the Digital City Twin and Bağkart in enhancing citizen services.

Graduates later presented their projects to attendees, and the program concluded with a certificate ceremony. It was announced that ongoing collaborations aim to integrate graduates into the workforce, while new mentorship and employment programs will support the career development of skilled software developers.

TürkSMD 16th Architecture Awards announced

The Architecture Awards, given biennially by the Turkish Association of Independent Architects (TürkSMD), have been announced. The awards ceremony took place on October 4th, at the Sheraton Hotel in Ankara, where 12 awards across five categories were presented. The event was attended by the award winners, jury members, prominent figures in the profession, and all companies supporting the ceremony.



The evening began with an opening speech by TürkSMD President Ali Osman Öztürk, who discussed the history of the association and the award program. He summarized the projects and work carried out over the past two years and mentioned the formation of alliances with newly established associations of independent architects. Öztürk also highlighted that all these associations have united under one umbrella, forming the Federation of Independent Architects' Associations. He emphasized that this federation will enable independent architectural services to continue more

effectively across the country with the establishment of associations in other cities. He thanked the jury members and all the supporting companies for their contributions to the awards and congratulated the winners on their success.

Prof. Dr. Namık Erkal, who chaired the jury for the 16th TürkSMD Awards, also gave a speech. He shared the criteria considered during the project evaluation and selection process, noting that architectural production outside of metropolitan areas stood out during this period. This demonstrated that there is a strong demand for quality architectural

services not only in major cities but also in other regions of the country. Prof. Dr. Erkal added that architectural works outside the scope of building construction, such as conservation and urban design, were evaluated in the special jury award category and congratulated all the winners in each category.

THE STRUCTURES, PEOPLE, AND PROJECTS OF THE NEW ERA IN TURKEY HAVE BEEN RECOGNIZED

Awards were given in five categories:

Grand Prize, Media Award, Contribution to Architecture Award, Building Award, and Jury Special Award. The Grand Prize was awarded to Kaya Arikoğlu. A total of 12 awards were presented, with three different projects receiving Building Awards, two projects receiving Media Awards, two individuals and one community being recognized for Contribution to Architecture, and three projects receiving Jury Special Awards.

AWARDS PRESENTED IN FIVE CATEGORIES TO 12 WINNERS

1. Grand Prize: Kaya Arikoğlu

Kaya Arikoğlu has contributed to the architectural profession not only through his independent practice but also through his academic work for over 50 years. His approach, maintaining a strong connection with his local geography and choosing to continue his architectural practice in Adana, is noteworthy. Arikoğlu has handled the fundamental concepts of architecture with a calm and understated approach, without compromise. His dialogue with local elements and his ability to re-evaluate modern architectural ideas within a structure's context allows him to produce unique works. In his designs, functionality and aesthetics are combined with tectonic elements, and simplicity is a key defining feature at every point. His consistent stance, adherence to professional ethics and values, and valuable contributions to his city and the architectural environment led to him being
